Tasmania's fuel supply **remains secure** and we continue to receive regular fuel deliveries as normal through the national supply chain.



All five of Tasmania's fuel terminals are stocked, with over 99% of fuel outlets also being fully stocked.



Tasmania remains aligned with the National Fuel Security Plan at Level 2 – Keeping Australia Moving.



The Tasmanian Government is keeping a close eye on fuel supplies and the ships bringing fuel into the state, and is working with the Australian Government and suppliers.



Tasmanians should continue to **purchase fuel as normal**, use FuelCheck TAS to check local availability, pricing and outages.

Taking action



Free bus and ferry travel will continue until 30 June 2027 to help reduce living costs.



Fuel laws were introduced to **improve transparency**, compliance and emergency response powers.



The Tasmanian Government worked with the Australian Government to **halve the fuel excise**, helping to ease cost pressures for households and businesses.



Consumer, Building and Occupational Services (CBOS) is actively **monitoring** fuel pricing compliance.
